## October 9 Projects

### Bartholomew County REMC

Build two specialized cabinets for the Book Express lending library. Will design the standing library, construct and install at a location of need in Columbus.

### Boone REMC

Paint interior and exterior of buildings at Maplelawn Farmstead, a historical site in Zionsville.

### Carroll White REMC

Assist the Monticello and Delphi parks departments with tree trimming and landscaping.

### Daviess-Martin County REMC

Provide assistance at West Boggs Park in Loogootee with park clean-up, landscaping and more.

### Decatur County REMC

Assist Decatur County Parks and Recreation with painting, pruning, raking and general maintenance of several parks.

### Heartland REMC

Conduct food drives at the cooperative's two offices in Markel and Wabash to benefit local food pantries.

### Hendricks Power Cooperative

Complete a variety of projects at Girl Scouts' Little House in Danville:

- Construct an outdoor fire pit area
- Dig trenching
- Landscape clean-up
- General maintenance

### Henry County REMC

Host a community event with live entertainment, exhibits, food and blood drive, flu shots, charity raffles, on-site recycling, safety demonstrations, bucket truck rides and more. Also includes free lunch, crafts for kids, wagon rides and face painting. Proceeds benefit local charitable organizations identified by cooperative employees.

### Indiana Electric Cooperatives

Complete a variety of projects at Fay Bickard Glick Neighborhood Center in Indianapolis:

- Paint three large interior rooms
- Clean up seven raised garden beds
- Office organization and filing

### Jackson County REMC

Stain the blacksmith building at Becks Mill in Salem, a local historical site being preserved.

### Jay County REMC

Provide assistance at Frank Merry Park in Dunkirk with park clean-up and painting, and install energy efficient lighting in the club house.

### Kankakee Valley REMC

Produce and install approximately 200 reflective mailbox signs to aid local emergency personnel and utilities in the location of rural addresses.

### LaGrange County REMC

- Assist ARC Opportunities, a Howe-based organization that supports individuals with disabilities:
  - Tree trimming and removal
  - Sort donated items at the organization's thrift store.
- Assist Ark Animal Rescue and Adoption, Inc., with yard projects

- Provide a live line safety class for local first responders

- Paint a room in the basement of Memorial Building for Kids Play, Inc.

- Assist with a cookout for residents at Good Shepherd Community
- Beautify the community sign at the north gateway into McCordsville, including top soil, mulch and plants
- Weed and mulch trees along Penny Trail for Regreening Greenfield
- Build a privacy wall to conceal air conditioning units and trash receptacles; build and place seating benches and flower boxes for Hancock County Arts Council
- Assist an elderly couple with yard maintenance on behalf of Hancock County Senior Services.
- Create a database for Leaders in Navigating Knowledge (LINK)

- Paint bleachers at Kenny Memorial Park in Ligonier
- Tree trimming, landscaping and sanding and painting light poles at Wolf Lake Park in Wolf Lake
