The Advanced Lineman Training Program (ALTP) is designed for line crew leaders from across the state to come together and hone their skills in line work, safety and leadership. In the three-year program, participants will spend two and a half days at the Franklin Training Center, once per year, where they will receive a combination of classroom and hands-on experience with industry best-practice work methods and equipment.

Class sizes will be limited to 12 participants so the experience can be as interactive as possible.

Classes are also limited to one participant per co-op, per session and spots will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
